Exploratory survey results involving 74 male students from Daystar University, Kenya

1. I am aware of the privileges enjoyed by boys and men in my community as a result of the value placed on them by culture
58 (78%) said, yes, I am
16 (22%) I'm not aware.
2. I am aware of the negative effects of male dominance on women and girls in my community
67 (91%) I am aware
7 (9%) I am not aware.
3. Did your upbringing and family prepare you to acknowledge and respect gender equality?
61 (82%), Yes, it did
13 (18%), No it didn't
4. Are you aware of any gender equality initiatives involving boys and men in your community?
26(35%), Aware
48 (65%), Not aware
5. Have you attended any form of training on gender equality in the last 1-3 years
28 (38%) Yes
46 (62%) No
6. Would you be willing to participate in a gender equality program involving men and boys
63 (85%) Willing
11(15%) Not willing
